

REFLECTION

The Our Father encapsulates the gospel in prayer. Some of the things we notice in the Our Father is that Jesus enjoins us to call His Father, our Father. Throughout the gospels, Jesus calls God Father 170 times. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus refers to God as Father 17 times.

We also see in this prayer 7 brief petitions which can thus be divided on the first 3 focused on God and the last 4 focused on us human beings.

In the **first** petition, which can be literally translated as "Let Your Name be hallowed," Jesus is teaching us to pray that the Father's name be treated as holy. It is a prayer that the whole world stops taking God's name in vain and treating it as sacred. The same can be extended to the name of Jesus.

In the **second** petition, "Thy Kingdom come," Our Lord is teaching us to pray for God's eternal kingdom to come down to earth. Christ certainly inaugurates the kingdom of God thorough His miracles and the mission of the Church. He also says that the final coming of the kingdom will take place only at that Last Judgment. On that day, as He says later, "the Son of Man" will sit on His glorious throne and say, "Come, O blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world" (Mt 25:31,34). It is a prayer for the final advent of eternal life.

In the **third** petition, "thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven" Our Saviour is teaching us to pray for the salvation of the world. As Jesus makes clear elsewhere, "It is no the will of my Father who is in heaven" that even "one" soul should perish (Mt 18:14). At the same time, doing the Father's will is essential for salvation: "Not every one who say to me 'Lord, Lord' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven" (Mt 7:21).

Next week we focus on the 4 last petitions.
