Dear Friends,

I became a parishioner at St. Francis de Sales Church 32 years ago. Later I began volunteering with a small group who gathered every Friday evening to decorate the gym at Saint Patrick's Catholic School to transform it into our worship space, before our new church here was built. This was truly a beautiful time for many young families who worked beside Father Roy; today many of us still get together. During our seven years in the gym, our decorations evolved from using fishing line with cut pieces of fabric stapled to dowling to then using aircraft wire and mathematical equations to create elaborate designs for our decorations and banners. At that time, we held many workshops for parishioners as we embarked together on a journey to build our new church. A large group of parishioners came together to form the capital campaign team and our theme was "From Living Stones, God's Chosen People." Today donor names are written on the foyer wall. They, with our volunteers, had a unique privilege to help build their new church and act in love to ensure God's people would have a new, larger space to gather.

Over the years, we've enjoyed many community events including:

Church picnics Strawberry Socials BBQs, Bake Sales and Bingos Christmas caroling

Sleigh rides Movie nights Lenten and Advent Retreats Vespers Themed dinners and dances International potlucks Winistry fairs Seniors' Luncheon

These events helped grow the community of 400 families in the gym to the 7,100 families registered today. The prayers and intentions of these earlier church volunteers and donors are buried on our current church grounds - a beautiful connection that binds the legacy of these people to us today.

I have enjoyed many positions within the Parish Office and Parish Ministries as well as working with all of our volunteers. Our parish today is truly blessed to have approximately 25 ministries and more than 500 volunteers. It has been an honour to serve as part of the St. Francis de Sales parish staff for the Past twenty years. Over my tenure, I have worked with ten priests, two deacons, and a wonderful dedicated staff. I feel that I was blessed with two families: my own family and my church family.

It has been an honour to serve you, the parish and our God. I will enjoy visiting and hearing how you continue to grow and build our church— together as one body with hearts of love and deeds of charity and good works

## **QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

I'm currently married to an Anglican man who was once married before in his church. He divorced his wife and now we were married civilly. Why does the Catholic Church insist that he receives an annulment from the Catholic Church before he can marry me? He's not Catholic.

When the Catholic Church looks at the many Protestant communities, she knows that they validly celebrate only two sacraments: Baptism and Marriage. They have only two valid sacraments because they do not have valid Holy Orders for the other 4 sacraments. In Marriage, it is the bride and groom who (as baptized lay persons) are the ministers of the sacrament. It is not the presiding deacon or priest or bishop who confers this sacrament on the couple. This holds true not only for Catholic couples but as well, Protestant ones. In the eyes of God and the Catholic Church, this Anglican man you referred to, is still married to his (previous) wife. The sacrament of Marriage can only end with death and not with a civil declaration of As a baptized person, he got married divorce. according to the terms of God, the Creator of the sacrament of Matrimony.

An annulment is not a declaration of the end of his (previous) marriage. An annulment does not deny that there was a marriage. An annulment is a declaration that the marriage **never began as a sacrament** as understood by the Catholic Church. Like any sacrament, it is "public property"; marriage, even though it is personal, ultimately belongs to the Church and to God. Moreover, as a Catholic yourself, you should be married in the presence of a Catholic deacon or priest for the sake of God's active grace in your life.

# So what difference does it make if we're married outside of the Catholic Church?

I know that there are many people in our congregation who fall within the ambit of the above example and are afraid to approach the priest for help for various reasons. The "difference" is that as a Catholic, you would not be able to receive validly Holy Communion or any of the other sacraments. I encourage any parishioner to approach either Fr. Joe or Fr. David for help. Ultimately, our concern is for the salvation of the person, to live out their married life the way God intended. We priests are not here to impose our "rules and regulations" nor are we going to condemn anyone. We are servants of Christ who seek to be faithful to His teachings as handed on by His Church.

Pope John Paul II in his teachings on the Theology of the Body stated that in married (sexual) life, the couple becomes an icon of the Trinitarian God. And to be faithful to this Image, a married couple needs the Grace of God.


