



QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

In last week's bulletin, you answered the question about a lady who is civilly married to a Protestant man (who was married before) stating that he had to receive an annulment from the Catholic Church. I'm civilly married to a non-baptized man who was previously married to a non-baptized woman. Do we have to do anything for this marriage?

There are many things you have to do for this marriage to be reconciled to the Catholic Church. For yourself, the Catholic party of this marriage, you must have this marriage validated by a Catholic priest or deacon before you receive the Eucharist. For this non-baptized gentleman, he needs to be released from his "first" marriage.

The Catholic Church looks upon his first marriage as valid but non-sacramental. For a marriage to be a sacrament, **both** bride and bridegroom **must be** baptized. This non-baptized gentleman needs to be released from his first marriage because of what St. Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 7:15-16, "If the unbeliever (the non-baptized) separates, however, let him separate. The brother or sister is not bound in such cases; God has called you to peace. For how do you know, wife, whether you will save your husband; or how do you know, husband, whether you will save your wife?"

This release from his first marriage is not an annulment, but another procedure known as the Pauline Privilege.

Does a Catholic always have to be married in the Catholic Church?

If that Catholic is interested in a sacramental life of the Church, then the answer is always **Yes**. A Catholic individual, **with the bishop's permission**, can choose to marry outside of the Catholic Church either civilly or in a non-Christian ceremony (if he or she is marrying a non-Christian). If the Catholic is marrying a baptized Protestant, the wedding may only take place in the Catholic Church or in that **particular** Protestant church, **only with the bishop's permission**.


