

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

In your previous bulletins, you mentioned that if

you were married outside of the Catholic Church you need to get your marriage validated by one of the priests. This is my situation but my (non-Catholic) spouse does not want to co-operate in getting the marriage validated. What am I to do? Do not despair. We can still work with the spouse who is willing to co-operate. From the unwilling spouse, we would need a copy of his or her Protestant baptismal certificate as well as the marriage certificate. The Catholic Church knows that not all spouses will co-operate. If one's spouse is non-baptized, we would only need a photocopy of the marriage certificate.

For what purposes are Catholics to have their marriage recognized by the Church? Is it just for the sake of laws or regulations?

It is for the sake of **one's salvation**. The Church's insight into marriage is not the same as our society. Society has chosen to reduce marriage only as an institution. This view of marriage has impoverished this greatest of love between man and woman in matrimony. Like other societal institutions, which have undergone change, many people today clamor for change in marriage. Society asks the rhetorical question: "If all institutions can change, why not marriage?" Hence, we have "same-sex marriage" and "trial marriages."

For the Church, however, the institutional part is the least (but not unimportant) of the ways of looking at marriage. When celebrated between 2 baptized persons, marriage is a sacrament, which makes visible what is invisible. The invisibility is that God Himself is a community of Persons. We humans image God in this way when we give ourselves completely as a gift to another human being (of the opposite gender) in marriage. God uses the visible things of this world to communicate His graces in the sacraments. Marriage is no different. Through the body of the spouse, God confers His Grace to the other spouse.


