## <u>COMMUNION SERVICES &</u> <u>PRIVATE PRAYER AT THE PARISH</u>

St. Francis de Sales parish will be open for **private prayer from Monday to Thursday from 10:30am to 12:30pm.** We are only allowed to have **10 individuals at a time including clergy and staff/ volunteers in the Church**. Please be mindful of the time you give to private prayer in the parish as there are other people who would like the opportunity to do the same.

We will be having Communion Services. Only 8 people are allowed to attend each 10 minute Communion Service. Please note this is not the celebration of Mass. To attend this Communion Service, you will have to register on Eventbrite. To access Eventbrite, please visit our website at <u>www.stfrancisdesales.ca</u> This Communion Service is limited only to Saturday evening and Sunday at specific times. This does not extend to the other days of the week.

For the times of the Communion Service, please see Eventbrite. If you are late for your Communion Service the entrance door to the parish will be locked and you will have to register for another date and time. Out of love for neighbour, we encourage you to register not more than once every two weeks to allow other parishioners to attend.

The Sacrament of Confession will be offered on Saturdays from 4pm to 4:45pm in the North and/or South Rooms.

#### **ONLINE DONATIONS**

If you are not able to attend, but still wish to donate, here are the ways in which you can continue to support our parish at this time:

# **REFLECTION**

Time is a creature fashioned by God so that we humans can give God His due honor and worship. Like each human being, all time is unique, never to be repeated. We call this time <u>chronos</u>. Our measurement of time, however is cyclical. In the Latin Rite of the Catholic Church, apart from the five liturgical seasons of the year: Advent, Christmas, Ordinary Time, Lent and Easter, and from various days on which Solemnities, Feasts and Memorials are celebrated, the Catholic Church dedicates the days of the week to particular themes.

Monday – Souls in Purgatory Tuesday - Holy Angels Wednesday – St. Joseph Thursday - Eucharist Friday – Passion of Jesus Saturday – Our Lady The months of the year also have various particular themes. It has been a long standing tradition of the Church to give prominence to several aspects of our Catholic faith. January - The Holy Name of Jesus February – The Holy Family March – St. Joseph April – The Holy Eucharist May – Our Lady June – The Sacred Heart of Jesus July - The Precious Blood of Jesus August – The Immaculate Heart of Mary September – The 7 Sorrows of Our Lady October – The Rosary November – The Holy Souls in Purgatory December – The Immaculate Conception From time to time, the Pope will declare a specific year with a theme. For instance, we are observing this year dedicated to St. Joseph (the observation of which began on 8 December 2020 and will conclude on 8

December 2021). Every 25 years within a century, the Church usually observes a Jubliee Year, the last being 2000, when we celebrated the Birth of the Messiah. In 2033 we will be observing the second millennium of the death of Jesus.

When God intervenes in our lives through the sacraments, we call this time, <u>Kairos</u>. At Mass, for example, the Sacrifice of the Cross and the Resurrection are re-presented to us. It is not that the Passion and Resurrection happen again and again, but that God makes it possible for us in our own day and time, to benefit in a Grace-filled manner from that which is the centre and culmination of all history.



#### FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

I pray that all of our First Communion families are well. As you have heard in the news, effective Monday April 19<sup>th</sup>, all in person religious services will be capped at 10 PEOPLE only. These restrictions will remain in effect for four weeks, which will unfortunately affect our dates for First Communion. For this reason, all of the May 15<sup>th</sup> First Communions will be postponed to a later date and the May 29<sup>th</sup> and June 5<sup>th</sup> First Communions are tentative. We will update our Parish website/bulletin once the lockdown is over and we are updated on when we can safely celebrate First Communions again. Please have your child continue to work on the First Communion preparation books at home. Father and I will send out the First Communion preparation videos to complement what the children are learning in their books, a little closer to the First Communion dates. We encourage you to pray daily as a family by using the prayer pamphlet that was given at registration and to watch Mass every Sunday. It is our faith that can truly help us get through some of these challenging days ahead. We look forward to when we can see all of you again and the children can celebrate their very special sacrament of First Communion. God bless!

#### **CONFIRMATION**

All Confirmation Masses are now postponed to a later date. Fr. Joe and I are already in discussion and communication regarding Confirmation for this year. When we hear word that restrictions will ease and we can <u>safely</u> celebrate Confirmation, I will let you know right away with what the tentative dates will be. Continue to monitor the website and bulletin for any further updates. Please continue to pray daily and to watch Mass weekly until we can gather together again safely.
