

ASH WEDNESDAY



On 17 February 2021 the Church will be celebrating Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday is not a day of obligation for Catholics. At St. Francis de Sales parish, we will be having Communion Services every 15 minutes starting at 10 a.m. until 12:45 p.m., and 6 p.m. to 7:45 p.m.. The Church will not be open for private prayer. <u>COMMUNION SERVICES &</u> <u>PRIVATE PRAYER AT THE PARISH</u>

St. Francis de Sales parish will be open for **private prayer from Monday to Thursday from 11am to 1pm.** We are only allowed to have **10 individuals at a time including clergy and staff/ volunteers in the Church**. Please be mindful of the time you give to private prayer in the parish as there are other people who would like the opportunity to do the same.

On Sundays, we will be having Communion Services. Only 8 people are allowed to attend each 10 minute Communion Service. Please note this is not the celebration of Mass. To attend this Communion Service, you will have to register on Eventbrite at <u>www.stfrancisdesales.ca</u> This Communion Service is limited only to Saturday evening and Sunday at specific times. This does not extend to the other days of the week.

If you are late for your Communion Service the entrance door to the parish will be locked and you will have to register for another date and time. Out of love for neighbour, we encourage you to register not more than once every two weeks to allow other parishioners to attend.

The Sacrament of Confession will be offered on Saturdays from 4pm to 4:45pm in the North and/or South Rooms.




