

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

We know little about the Magi. They come from the East and journey to Bethlehem, following an astrological sign, so we believe them to be astrologers.....



In Matthew's Gospel, they represent the Gentiles' search for a savior. Because the Magi represent the entire world, they also represent our search for Jesus.

We have come to consider the gifts they bring as a foreshadowing of Jesus' role in salvation. We believe the meaning of the gifts to be Christological. Gold is presented as representative of Jesus' kingship. Frankincense is a symbol of his divinity because priests burned the substance in the Temple. Myrrh, which was used to prepare the dead for burial, is offered in anticipation of Jesus' death.

The word Epiphany means "manifestation" or "showing forth." Historically several moments in Christ's early life and ministry have been celebrated as "epiphanies," including his birth in Bethlehem, the visit of the Magi, his baptism by John, and his first miracle at Cana.

COMMUNION SERVICES & PRIVATE PRAYER AT THE PARISH

Effective Monday 4 January, St. Francis de Sales parish will be open for private prayer from Monday to Thursday from 11am to 1pm. We are only allowed to have 10 individuals at a time including clergy and staff/volunteers in the Church. Please be mindful of the time you give to private prayer in the parish as there are other people who would like the opportunity to do the same.

Starting 9 January, we will be having Communion Services. Only 8 people are allowed to attend each 10 minute Communion Service. Please note this is not the celebration of Mass. To attend this Communion Service, you will have to register on Eventbrite. To access Eventbrite. please visit our website www.stfrancisdesales.ca This Communion Service is limited only to Saturday evening and Sunday at specific times. This does not extend to the other days of the week. For the times of the Communion Service, please see Eventbrite. If you are late for your Communion Service the entrance door to the parish will be locked and you will have to register for another date and time. Out of love for neighbour, we encourage you to register once every two weeks to allow other parishioners to attend.

The entrance to the Church has changed once again. You will now be required to enter through the front door.

The Sacrament of Confession will be offered on Saturdays from 4pm to 4:45pm in the North and/or South Rooms.

These times for Communion Service and Private Prayer are subject to change based on restrictions in Ontario and by the Archdiocese of Toronto. Please keep checking our parish website for continual updates.

REFLECTION

What is this thing called an indulgence? Is this something left over from the Medieval period that the Church did not get rid of?

An indulgence is a remission of the temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In other words, an indulgence is the application of God's divine mercy to remove the effects of past sins. An indulgence is not forgiveness itself nor is it absolution. The Church cannot get rid of indulgences because of the consequences of sin.

How is an indulgence related to sin?

Sin can have two consequences: eternal punishment in Hell or temporal punishment in purgatory. Unrepentant and unforgiven mortal sin results in eternal punishment. Forgiven sins are free from eternal punishment, but they retain a temporal punishment. It is God's mercy that forgives sin, but it is God's justice that rewards good and punishes evil. Think of an indulgence in this manner. If you spilled wine on your friend's floor, you've made a mess. Upon apologizing to your friend, you've made amends with him or her. However, you still have the job of cleaning up the spilled mess. Sin is precisely like this example. An indulgence however, seeks to remove that mess without you doing the actual job.

There are two types of indulgences: plenary and partial. A plenary indulgence removes all temporal punishment due to sin. A partial indulgence removes some to the temporal punishment.

How does one get this plenary indulgence?

There are many novenas, prayers etc. by which one can get a plenary indulgence. However, there are 3 conditions which have to be fulfilled.

- (1) Perform the prescribed prayers or works of charity,(2) Go to Confession and Holy Communion 7 days
- (2) Go to Confession and Holy Communion 7 days before or after; and
- (3) To be free from all attachment to sin, even venial sin.

No one can buy a plenary or partial indulgence. To gain an indulgence, one has to be in the state of grace, that is free from any attachment of sin, even venial sins. If one had sorrow from his or her sins, confessed them, and had been absolved and then performed a charitable work, such as giving alms, then that person could be eligible for an indulgence.

This weekend as we celebrate the Epiphany of Our Lord, let us bring not gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh, but our contrite hearts and lives. To be in God's grace, is one of the most wonderful things we can ever have.


