



This Communion Service is limited only to Saturday evening and Sunday at specific times. This does not extend to the other days of the week. For the times of the Communion Service, please see Eventbrite. Please arrive early. If you are late for your Communion Service the entrance door to the parish will be locked and you will have to register for another date.

The Sacrament of Confession will be offered on Saturdays from 4pm to 4:45pm in the North and/or South Rooms.


REFLECTION

These days, with many fads and controversial opinions swirling about us, many are jumping on the band wagon leading them to God knows where. Sentimentality and emotions seem to be guiding post of the day, which stands in contra-distinction to the Church's use of faith and reason. Fr. Jeffrey Kirby in his book: *Real Religion, How to Avoid False Faith and Worship God in Spirit and Truth*, teaches us about the role of the heart. Says the wise Fr. Kirby, on the path to true worship, there will be struggles along the way. We are fallen beings, and in our fallenness, we are inclined to incomplete worship or even to a well disguised self-worship. Our sentiments and emotions want to corrode reality and make our hearts the center of all things.

When Sacred Scripture speaks about the "heart", it is not referring to the epicenter of our emotions or even how we feel in the popular sense but rather to the place where truth is discovered (not invented) and where we are revealed to ourselves and where we encounter the living God. The "heart" is also a reference to our conscience. But just as the heart has been redefined in our modern world, so has conscience. Properly understood in the biblical sense, the conscience is the inner sanctuary of the person, where he/she communicates not only with himself/herself but also with God. There, in the hidden meeting place of his/her interior life, the moral law and the person's freedom interact and make decisions.

As human beings, made in the Image of God, we have a selfpossession born from our spiritual souls. This self possession is the ground upon which we share in God's own divine reason. It is the basis upon which our sentiments and emotions move. If a person does not have some form of an interior life, and lacks an attentive ear to his/her conscience, then he or she can be easily mislead regarding what is true and good. Conscience is not some type of divine oracle sent down from the gods upon the mind of a person, nor is it merely our personal wish or some type of super ego, nor is it the consensus of voices within the person. Conscience is not the place where "we figure things out for ourselves" or where we find emotional fulfillment or where we create our own reality. If sentiment overtakes our conscience, then we are imprisoned in a small, self-created world, where good and evil become whatever we think or feel they should be. In such a dark world, we become slaves to the whims, shallowness and cruelty of our own emotions. In the process, our sentiments demand that we worship them and then by extension we end up worshipping ourselves. These are exactly opposite of conscience.

At times, sentiment assaults our hearts and we are tempted to compromise with evil, to betray goodness or to redefine it. Though good and oriented toward goodness, the human heart is also fallen. It can betray itself and its own mission in our interior lives. The prophet Jeremiah warns us: 'The heart is deceitful above all things in desperately corrupt; who can understand it" (Jer 17:9). In His public ministry, Our Lord Jesus was cautious about the human heart: "Now when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover feast, many believed in his name when they saw the signs which he did;

but Jesus did not trust himself to them, because he knew all men and needed no one to bear witness of man; for he himself knew what was in man" (Jn 2:23-25).

To worship Jesus in the Church is more bending one's knee in the Church. Catholic moral teaching is not about rules, regulations and prohibitions. It is above all having a relationship with Christ in His Mystical Body, the Church. And to aid us in this regard, it is good to have a well informed conscience. In moments of temptation or duplicity, treachery or sentimentality, the strength of a truly well informed conscience will clarify any confusion, convict us and guide us to remaining faithful to virtue and its demands.


