





COMMUNION SERVICES & PRIVATE PRAYER AT THE PARISH

St. Francis de Sales parish will be open for **private prayer** from Monday to Thursday from 10:30am to 12:30pm. We are only allowed to have 10 individuals at a time including clergy and staff/ volunteers in the Church. Please be mindful of the time you give to private prayer in the parish as there are other people who would like the opportunity to do the same.

We will be having Communion Services. Only 8 people are allowed to attend each 5 minute Communion Service. Please note this is not the celebration of Mass. To attend this Communion Service, you will have to register on Eventbrite. To access Eventbrite, please visit our website at www.stfrancisdesales.ca. This Communion Service is limited only to Saturday evening and Sunday at specific times. This does not extend to the other days of the week. For the times of the Communion Service, please see Eventbrite. Please arrive early. If you are late for your Communion Service the entrance door to the parish will be locked and you will have to register for another date.

The Sacrament of Confession will be offered on Saturdays from 4pm to 4:45pm in the North and/or South Rooms.

REFLECTION

As a few Catholic School Boards within the Archdiocese of Toronto have decided to fly the Gay Pride rainbow flag on their properties, we need to make our distinctions regarding homosexuality. Too often, many people wrongly think that in condemning homosexuality, the Catholic Church is condemning the person. To untwist the confusion surrounding the Church's teaching on homosexuality, there are 3 distinctions we need to look at: **the person, the sexual orientation and the act.**


Each **person** is made in the Image and Likeness of God. Each **person** is loved into existence in space and time (history) by a loving God. The Church cannot condemn what God has lovingly willed to exist, that is the **human person**, a union of body and soul.

Closely related to the human person is **human nature**. This human nature is the "stuff" out of which we were made. This human nature is also made in the Image and Likeness of God.

Orientation pertains to the sexual "outlook" of the person. Many gays and lesbians legitimately say that they did not choose their orientation but that their same-sex orientation chose them. In talking about same-sex orientation, the Church has chosen the word, disordered. Again, many wrongly assume that upon hearing the word 'disordered', it refers to the person and not the sexual orientation. Hence the vitriol and hatred thrown at the Church. "Disordered" may indeed be an outdated word and the Church has to look for another word to describe pastorally sexual (Interestingly enough, when society orientation. talks about a person having Attention Deficit Disorder, [ADD], no one assumes that it refers to the **person** but perhaps to their concentration ability). To have a samesex orientation is not a sin and it does not endanger one's salvation. To have a same-sex orientation, does **not** mean that God loves the person any less.

The **act** refers to the sexual behaviour of the person. Any sexual act outside of (heterosexual) marriage is a sin and is condemned in Sacred Scripture and the Church. Any sexual act outside of marriage, freely consented to and with deliberation of thought, imperils one's salvation. It is old fashioned to say but still very appropriate to state that "the Church does not condemn the sinner but the sin" not the person but the act.

Holy Spirit, have mercy on us. Our Lady, pray for us. St. Charles Lwanga and Companions, pray for us.
