

Monetary Donations can be placed in SVDP Christmas Collection Envelopes:


- Parishioners with numbered offertory envelopes, please use the Green SVDP Christmas Collection envelope dated November 20.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

My wife and I have used IVF (In Vitro Fertilization) to achieve pregnancy. What does the Church have to say about IVF?

If the use of contraception is about unity between the couple with no procreative side, then the use of IVF seeks procreation without the unitive. We know the Church has always insisted that the sexual act be potentially procreative (that is without any barrier) but what many people forget is that the same Church teaches that the same sexual act must be unitive. In other words, both the unitive and the procreative sides are of equal value which we cannot dissect at will. Both the unitive and procreative sides were inscribed into the sexual act by our Creator. The sexual act is a faint echo of the life-giving and unitive-dimension aspects within the Trinitarian God we worship.

IVF is the process of removing ova and sperm from their parents and combining them *in vitro* ("in glass") in a laboratory. The resulting embryo is then implanted in the womb of either the mother or a surrogate. IVF may be used in conjunction with other reproductive technologies such as pre-implantation testing and it often relies on donated ova and sperm.

IVF has a more destructive impact on the unborn child than abortion. In fertility clinics, both sperm and ova are frozen for future use. Some "leftover" embryos are frozen, donated for research or discarded. If the mother ends up with a multiple pregnancy, she may choose a "fetal reduction." In other words, to bring one child to life normally involves sacrificing other embryos.

Some may think that if a couple only fertilizes one ovum that IVF is acceptable. As stated above, we cannot dissect for the sexual act always has a double meaning. As with abortion, IVF not only threatens the lives of the unborn, it disrespects them. IVF and its related technologies treat children not as people but as the objects of manufacture. At every step of the process of IVF, embryos are processed and graded with the goal of quality control. Embryos that do not made the grade on this human assembly line can easily be discarded.

There are many couples who find themselves unable to achieve pregnancy. There are also individuals who are not married but would like to have children who are using IVF.

The Church accepts children conceived by means of IVF. What the Church condemns is, not the pregnancy, but the MEANS to pregnancy.

There is a lot of money that goes into the manufacture of babies. And there are certain things that should not be for sale or rent like, ova, sperm and wombs. The use of IVF needs to be confessed.

Question & Answer Cont'd...

So, what is a couple to do if they're infertile? Does the Church not care for them?

The Church has no objection in medical science **assisting** (**not replacing**) the unitive dimension in achieving pregnancy. The Catholic Church has taught from the onset that fertility medicine must assist the natural process, where conception takes place in the marital embrace (between husband and wife) and the baby comes to term in the mother's womb. This includes fertility medication, and more importantly that the unitive dimension of sexuality is respected. This means that once a married couple has sexually united, conception is "helped" by medical science in uniting sperm and ova within the woman.


