
Prepare to Confess

REFLECTION

This week we look at the sixth phrase of Jesus from the Cross: **"It is finished"** with the help of the late Bishop Fulton Sheen. Sometimes this phrase of Jesus is translated as "It is consummated."

The Heavenly Father in His divine mercy willed to restore man to his pristine glory. In order that the portrait might once more be true to the Original, God willed to send to earth His Divine Son, according to whose Image man was made, that the earth might see once more the manner of the man God wanted us to be. In the accomplishment of this task, only Divine Omnipotence could use the elements of defeat as the elements of victory. The work, which His Father had given Him to do, was accomplished. We were bought and paid for. We were won in a battle fought not with five stones, like those with which David slew Goliath, but with five wounds, hideous scars on hands and feet and side. Jesus has finished the ark, opening His side with a spear and clothing Himself in the garment of His precious blood.

With this sixth phrase, Jesus is saying that **"It is consummated."** The redemption of man is finished. Love had completed its mission, for Love had done all that it could. There are two things Love can do. Love by its nature tends to an incarnation and every incarnation tends to a crucifixion. Does not all true love tend toward an incarnation? In the order of human love, does not the affection of husband and wife create from their mutual loves the incarnation of their confluent love in the form of a child? Once they have begotten their child, do they not make sacrifices for him or her, even to the point of death? And thus, love tends to a crucifixion.

Jesus finished Redemption in His Physical Body, but we have not finished it in His Mystical Body. Jesus has finished Salvation; we have not yet applied it to our souls. Jesus has finished the model Cross; we must fashion ours to its pattern. Jesus has finished the Sacrifice of Calvary; we must finish the Mass. The Crucifixion was not meant to be an inspirational drama, but a pattern act on which we model our lives.
