THE SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE,

marks the end of the liturgical year. The second coming of the Lord will have the glorified King, Jesus Christ, presenting all creation and souls to God the Father. This feast was established in 1925 by Pope Pius XI because of so much secularism in the world. The emphasis was that the kingship of Christ is not based on human power but on loving and serving others.

According to St Augustine, there are two kinds of people, two kinds of love. There is the holy or love of God and there is the selfish or the love of the world (concupiscence). The holy love seeks out the love of God and is subject to Him. The other endeavors to equal Him.

...The constitution of the Kingdom of God are the beatitudes. We are called to live these beatitudes according to our function in life in following Jesus. The beatitudes are personal but yet communal. Jesus lived out humility, mercy and meekness He proved His love for us by overcoming sin, sickness, pain and death. His death was the atoning sacrifice for our sins.

...Each one of us is to participate in this Kingdom and to spread the Word in the new covenant of servitude, truth, life and love. The Lord lives in our families, our friends, our community, neighbors, those in line at the St Vincent de Paul office, the isolated, forgotten, imprisoned, strangers and those who live in foreign and remote lands.

He will reward those who fed Him, clothed Him, cared for Him, visited Him and who allowed Him in their hearts. And so when He presents us to His Father, our words and deeds to expand the Kingdom will be rewarded.

And we can hear Him say, 'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.'

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

What is Purgatory? Part 2

We are called to enter into God's own self-giving love in this life. It is God's self-giving, life-giving love that we, as Christians, are called into being with one another and with God. The difficulty comes when we understand and realize that we are not always capable of entering into that kind of love. Jesus came to earth and poured forth his life for the forgiveness of our sins. He suffered and died on the cross for us. God the Father sent His only Son to suffer and die an excruciating death for our failures, our mistakes, and our atrocities against God. Most of us, if we are honest, can admit we would not be willing to die for someone else's crimes.

It is crucial to understand the three misconceptions about purgatory. Purgatory is not a physical place, it is not a second-chance, and it is not a "do-over" for our life. Purgatory is a process of being purged. We all have attachments to this world that get in the way of us loving like Christ loves and how we fully love him. The attachments we have to this life and this world prevent us from fully serving, loving, and experiencing God. It is those attachments that are burned up in the process of purgatory. St. Paul writes about this process to the Corinthians.

"But if someone's work is burned up, that one will suffer loss; the person will be saved, but only as through fire." (I Corinthians 3:15)

We trust in the Lord and He knows what is best for us and what we need better than we even know ourselves. Purgatory is not a punitive place where God beats us, condemns us, and reminds us of how terrible we are as His children. It is a state of purification that is also a recognition of our own limitations and weaknesses in this life while simultaneously acknowledging the infinite power of God's love.

Purgatory is not a place where God is saying that you're not good enough. It is a state of God, in fact, proclaiming that you indeed are good enough to be called a child of God.

Supper Saints are parishioners who have decided to **provide ALL or PART of the supper meal** for those who are attending Life Teen. If part of the supper is offered, a second Supper Saint would be scheduled on the same night. Our attendance fluctuates throughout the year, but we aim to prepare **food for approximately 30 teens and 10 leaders.** Offering your time and talent to bring supper for such a large group is a very large task and is greatly appreciated. If you would like to get involved and are unable to cook a meal, we would gladly accept a monetary contribution to sponsor a meal.

A full supper consists of:

- 1. A vegetable dish (salad, fresh or hot veggies)
- 2. A main dish
- 3. A dessert (fruits, sweets **or** frozen...)

What does a Supper Saint do?

- Decide what meal to provide and buy accordingly
- Deliver the supper (or part of it) before 7:00PM on the designated date, ready to serve. *If it is a challenge to deliver it hot, we can make arrangements to deliver it earlier, so it can be heated in the oven at the Church*
- Always avoid ALL NUTS
- Please, no meat during Lent (beef, poultry, and pork)
- If delivering the supper in containers that you would like returned, please make sure your name is on them
- You are welcome to provide your receipts for reimbursement

We will supply plates, cutlery and napkins.


