

## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

### My husband/wife and I were married outside of the Catholic Church. However, he/she does not want to have the marriage blessed in the Catholic Church. What can I do?

If your husband/wife is unwilling to have your marriage blessed in the Catholic Church, you (the interested party) can still approach us priests for an appointment and we can do our best to have your marriage recognized by the Church. *Until your marriage is blessed by a priest or deacon, we ask that you just receive a blessing at Communion time by crossing your arms over your chest, instead of receiving the Eucharist*. Holy Communion (between Christ and His Bride the Church) is reflected in the Eucharist and so it should be reflected in a holy common union between husband and wife, the way Christ intended marriage to be.

Has a Catholic ever been "legitimately" married outside the Catholic Church without ever having to get the marriage blessed by a priest?

Yes, within certain parameters a Catholic can be married legitimately outside the Catholic Church. For this to happen, the bishop's office is usually involved to grant this permission.

### In last week's bulletin, you stated that marriage is linked to one's salvation, that is, saving one's soul. Can you explain this some more?

God made Marriage in His Image and Likeness. In Marriage, a person goes from an "I" to a "WE"; from a singular "entity" to a plural entity. One can even say that in Marriage there are two "I's".

In the Marriage ceremony the purpose of our earthly life is driven home to the couple, in that, God has put them into each other's life so that they can help each other get to heaven. The four vows which a couple takes in a Catholic ceremony mimics the relationship between Jesus and His Bride. Marriage outside the Catholic Church does not stress this point.

We all want to spend our eternity in heaven with God and we should also want it for our spouse and by extension the children that will come from that union. In Marriage, Christ provides all the necessary graces needed for an intimate union.

## Sacrament Registration for First Reconciliation/Communion & Confirmation

We are so excited to begin another sacramental year! It has been so nice to see all of our sacramental families over the last couple weeks for the First Reconciliation/Communion and Confirmation meetings. These meetings are mandatory for your child to receive their sacrament for the 2023/2024 year. If you missed the above meetings, we will have one final make-up meeting on Thursday October 12<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm, at the Parish for both First Communion and **Confirmation.** Please contact Dawn Selda if you will be attending for First Communion and Noah Aquino if you will be attending for Confirmation. If you attended the registration meeting already but did not submit your child's registration forms yet, please ensure you communicate with the coordinators to arrange a time to drop off the forms. Your child's passport will be given once all forms are received. Please remember to pick up a bulletin and have your child have that stamped at the passport stamping table until your child receives their passport

We are looking forward to seeing all of the children and their families at Mass, as they prepare for these very special sacraments!
