



Highlights of Experience and Traits Required:

- Committed to prayer, gospel values and growth in personal holiness.
- Understands the sacredness of the Eucharistic encounter.
- Willing to develop skills of gracious movement and a consciousness of body language.

Liturgical Hospitality: Greeters and Ushers NEEDED

Duties Include:

- Welcome parishioners, be attentive to newcomers, children, the elderly and those with special needs
- Receive collections, and seat late arrivals and persons with disabilities
- Assist in the movement of the assembly during Holy Communion
- . Carry the collection up (in pairs) when gifts are being presented and ensures its security

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

I am a Catholic, yet the parish sometimes gives me a hard time because my baptismal certificate says I'm a Melkite Catholic. Why?

In the Catholic Church, we have many Rites. To explain what a Rite in the Catholic Church is, think of a political map of Canada.

Canada is divided up into 10 provinces, each with its own Premier, who speaks only for his/her province. Over and above these provinces is the Prime Minister, who speaks and rules for the whole of Canada.

In the Catholic Church we have 22 provinces. These provinces are known as rites. Each rite supposedly has its own Patriarch who speaks for his own Rite. The Latin Rite of the Catholic Church is headquartered in Rome by the Bishop of Rome, the Pope. The Pope, however wears 2 hats; he is not only the head of the Latin Rite but also the "Prime Minister" of the whole Catholic Church.

The patriarch of each rite expects certain things of their own followers. For example, if a Syro-Malabar Rite couple has a baby, the patriarch of that rite expects that that baby should be baptized in a Syro-Malabar Catholic Church. This is not a policy of any individual priest or of the parish office or of our Toronto Chancery. And as such, there are times when baptism or marriage is put forward, we have to forward the couple to a parish which serves their own Rite.

So, does that mean that as an Eastern Rite Catholic, I can't attend Mass at a Latin rite Parish?

Yes, you can still attend a Latin rite parish and receive Holy Communion and Confession. Some of our *Confirmandi*, upon handing in their baptismal certificates, are unaware that some of them may have been confirmed on the very day of their baptism. Furthermore, if that is the case, we cannot confirm them again as Confirmation can only be received once. Some of those Rites also give their newly baptized their first Communion sacrament. Hence, we also have to alert parents belonging to the eastern rites that their child has already received Holy Communion.

What are these Catholic Rites?

They are: Coptic, Eritrean, Ethiopian, Armenian, Albanian, Belarusian, Bulgarian, Byzantine, Macedonian, Hungarian, Melkite, Romanian, Ruthenian, Slovak, Ukrainian, Chaldean, Syro-Malabar, Maronite, Syro-Malankara, Syriac and Latin. Please note that these Rites are different than the Orthodox rite churches.

Your child's passport will be given once all forms are received. Please remember to pick up a bulletin and have your child have that stamped at the passport stamping table until your child receives their passport. All outstanding documents must be submitted by October 27 to be registered for this year's sacraments.

We are looking forward to seeing all of the children and their families at Mass, as they prepare for these very special sacraments!


