



### REFLECTION

### St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians

(This week and the following weeks, we will look at the content of St. Paul's letters in the New Testament. By no means can we exhaust the many meanings in those individual letters).

- St. Paul wrote this letter to Philippians while he was in prison in Rome awaiting his death. This letter is about sanctity or Christ-mindedness. Here are some highlights of Philippians.
- (1) For those, like parents, teachers and pastors, entrusted to the care of souls in danger of losing the faith: "I am sure that He who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ" (1:6). Faith is a work of God and God never gives up and never fails.
- (2) Paul does not describe sanctity as imitating Christ, but as living in Christ. "For me to live is Christ and to die is gain" (1:21).
- (3) The most famous passage in this letter is the "kenosis" (self-emptying) passage (2:5-11): "Though He was in the form of God, Jesus did not count equality with God, a thing to be grasped but emptied Himself that the form of a slave, being born in the likeness of men..." Christianity calls for us to take on the mind of Christ and the hope of glory.
- (4) St. Paul practices what he preaches. Paul puts no confidence in the flesh, that is, human and worldly advantages. After listing all his considerable advantages (3:4-8), St. Paul summarizes them as "refuse."
- (5) The goal in this life in Christ is summarized in 3:10-11: "...that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and may share His sufferings, becoming like Him in His death, that, if possible, I may attain the resurrection of the dead." Salvation is both complete when Jesus said, "It is finished" (Jn 19:30) and incomplete. For while God has made us His own, we have not completely made Him our own. A constant incompleteness and energy animates the Christian life, like a race: "Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect; but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me His own. Brethren, I do not consider that I have made it my own; but one thing I do, forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus" (3:12-14).


