

PARKING ENFORCEMENT

The safety and security of our parishioners are of utmost importance. Please respect the fire routes and DO NOT park in front of them. Please do not park in a fire route – even if you have an Accessible Permit! It only takes a second for an emergency to happen. You never know when emergency vehicles will need to access a fire route. Do not stand, stop, or park in an Accessible Parking Space without a valid permit displayed and the person it has been issued to is the driver or passenger. Recently, fire trucks and ambulances have had a hard time accessing the parking lot for emergency situations due to vehicles being parked in no parking zones and driveways. Time is crucial if a parishioner needs medical attention and needs to be rushed to the hospital. Bylaw officers will issue tickets to those who do not comply. We thank you for helping us keep the driveways and area easily accessible.

FIRST RECONCILIATION/HOLY COMMUNION

We are looking forward to seeing all the children during the upcoming enrollment weekend. Please note that the enrollment weekend (this is when the children will receive their blessed crosses) will take place on **November 30/December 1** for **First Communion**. Please attend the Mass time that works best for your family. Father will call the children up to receive their blessed cross after the homily and the children will remain at the front to sing a song. This is also the first passport collection date as well. The passports will be stamped and collected after Mass and they will be returned to our 6 Parish schools throughout the week. If your child attends public, private or other Catholic schools, the passports will be returned the following week to their RCIC class.


