

REFLECTION

A new liturgical year, Year 'C', is well under way, but the calendar year of 2024 is still drawing to a close.

We are soon to celebrate Christmas, the birth of Jesus, our Saviour, in Bethlehem. Through baptism we are sons and daughters of God and brothers and sisters to one another. Jesus came to offer everyone an opportunity to share in God's Divine Life, beginning in Baptism and strengthened through the other Sacraments. 1 John 4:16 tells us "God is love, and those who abide in love abide in God, and God abides in them".

With the many conflicts happening in our world, the suffering of the poor and homeless, and many facing numerous life challenges, it might be easy to begin to doubt the love of God.

However, God empowers us with His Divine Life and Love through the sacraments that we might be moved through faith to share that love with others, thus helping in His plan to change and save the world.

Love-willing the good of another for their own sake and not for anything in return. This is how God wants us to build a world of peace, hope, joy, and love. God wants us to put faith into concrete action through the fruit of prayer and compassionate service to others (see. Galatians 5:6). Do not lose hope. Do not give up on the power of love

Do not lose hope. Do not give up on the power of love when supernaturally charged through faith and God's grace. Look at the global transformation that was begun through a handful of Apostles.

We lack faith, and so we lack prayer. We lack prayer and so we lack love. We lack love and so we lack peace.

The spirit of giving at Christmas is inescapably linked to faith in Jesus Christ and being open to the grace of God in our lives through the power of the Holy Spirit (see Luke 11:13). The love which flows from faith is powerful.

Do not wait for change to come from the world. Start with yourself and your family. As an individual and as a family pray daily the Rosary and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. Go to Mass at least once a week. Use the Sacrament of Reconciliation frequently. Read your Bible. Pray for the grace to live faithfully the Commandments and the Beatitudes. Get active in the spiritual and corporal works of mercy. If the majority of Catholics put great effort into this spiritual program what wonders might be seen as we pray for God's blessing upon us? If the majority of Christians lived with such spiritual faith what great accomplishment can be achieved.

It might seem that we do not have the faith of the centurion (see Luke 7:1-10), nor the perseverance of the persistent widow (see Luke 18:1-8).

But we can and need to trust God and pray. The prayer of faithful Israelites helped to fulfill the promise of the coming of the Messiah. The prayer of faithful Christians can help to fulfill Christ's desire to overcome sin and the divisions which stem from sin (see Romans 6:12-14).

As Catholic Christians we are about to celebrate and welcome baby Jesus in the manger at Bethlehem. Do not be fooled; in that small baby is the immensity of the power of God. Be filled with joy as you realize that you are not helpless against the darkness of our present age. The call of the angel's trumpet sounds and it calls to you. Strengthen your prayer life, your conversation and fellowship with God through Jesus Christ.

This is how the true spirit of Christmas, the spirit of Christ, can be reborn in your life.

On behalf of the clergy and staff of St. Francis De Sales Parish, may God's love be poured into your hearts and grant to everyone a very Blessed and Merry Christmas!


