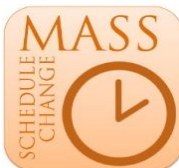

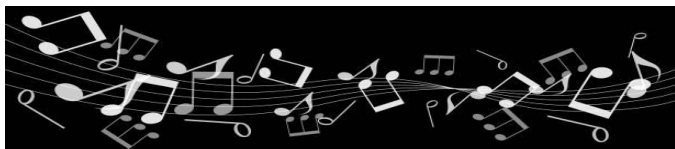
THE 2025 BISHOP'S ALTAR SERVER AWARD
