PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING

As we begin a new year, the Parish Finance Council asks you to consider the Pre-Authorization Giving Plan (PAG). If you are already a PAG user, it is a good time to review and consider updating your monthly giving. It is now possible to include Mortgage & Building Fund Donations in your monthly PAG.

For other parishioners, you can simplify your donations with the convenience of a once monthly (20th day each month) direct debit from your selected bank account. You can now utilize this for Regular Offertory, Mortgage and Building Fund donations. An added convenience, this allows continual support for the parish when you are away. For other donations you can continue to use envelopes provided.

For the Parish, PAG allows the parish to plan better through regular and dependable flow of contributions, and the added benefit of the reduction of paperwork and bookkeeping.

Some parishioners have indicated a preference to donate by credit card. Credit card service fees take from 1.5 -3% for each individual donation. Whereas with PAG there is only a .14 cent administration fee per total amount of your monthly donations.


